JUDICIAL MEETING MINUTES

- I. CALL TO ORDER** – Charlie Weis, Judicial Chairman; called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- II. PRESENT** – Chairman, Charlie Weis; Village President, Jeff Roberts; and Members, Darrell Sears and Sarah Casady. Also Present: Brenda Bentley; Dawn Sargent; and Chief, Michael Spafford. Absent: None.
- III. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 298. ZONING, ARTICLE V. TRAFFIC, PARKING AND ACCESS § 298-43. OFF-STREET PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS DISCUSSION** – The discussion focused on § 298-43. C (2) Vehicle limitations. It states that only two vehicles licensed as trucks may be parked on a residential lot. Such vehicles are limited in size to a maximum of one-ton capacity. It was the consensus of the committee that the ordinance is outdated and needs to be rewritten. Chairman, Weis will have Clerk-Treasurer, Bjorklund research what other municipalities are doing with larger trucks and the requirements in their villages for parking on a residential lot. More discussion will take place regarding amendment of the ordinance at a future meeting.
- IV. TRAINING DISCUSSION** – Chief, Spafford stated that on November 3, 2016 there will be a TraCS User Conference. Traffic and Criminal Software (TraCS) runs on both computers and laptop computers in squad cars. This allows the officer to immediately enter data in the squad car on the squad computer, or at a later time in the police office. The Driver/vehicle information used can be shared among other forms, eliminating duplicate entries. Chief, Spafford noted that he wants to take the training to officially start using TraCS in the Webster Police Department. The committee approved Chief, Spafford’s attendance at this one-day conference.
- V. LAW ENFORCEMENT DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE (LEDC) APPOINTMENTS DISCUSSION** – Chairman, Weis introduced Brenda Bentley and Dawn Sargent, who were asked to join the LEDC. Both women accepted appointment. The committee will recommend their appointment to the Full Village Board at the November 9, 2016 Regular Board Meeting. Their term will start January 1, 2017 once accepted. Chairman, Weis noted that the committee will be looking for a 3rd member to be part of the committee.
- VI. MOTION TO ADJOURN** – Motion to adjourn the Judicial Committee Meeting at 6:21 p.m. was made by Village President, Roberts; seconded by Member, Casady. **Motion carried 4-0.**
