JUDICIAL “QUARTERLY” MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday – June 9, 2015
6:00 p.m. @Village Office
7505 Main Street West, Webster, WI

- I. **CALL TO ORDER** – Charlie Weis, Judicial Chairman; called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- II. **PRESENT** – Village President, Jeff Roberts; Chairman, Charlie Weis; and Member, Darrell Sears. Also Present: Tessa Anderson, Municipal Court Clerk; Brian Sears, Court Judge; and Chief, Michael Spafford. Absent: None.
- III. **COURT CLERK UPDATES** – Court Clerk, Anderson presented the 2014 Municipal Court Statistics. The total court intake for 2015 to date is \$8,815.03. The court retained \$4,894.42 of that amount. Expenses for April and May were \$634.04 and 582.43 respectively. There were 43 traffic tickets written for those months. The balance owed to the court is \$34,783.77 for outstanding tickets. For 2015 there was \$10,331.49 recovered for warrants and tax interception. Court Clerk, Anderson stated that the Webster Municipal Court computer is in bad shape. The committee discussed her purchasing a new one. They noted there are enough funds available to do this. She will research the purchase of a new computer. Another issue is the need to have software that is compatible with the Webster Police Department for her computer. Right now the old TIPS program is in her computer. The software that the Webster PD will be using is SLEET Software and that still needs to be updated on her end. The representative for SLEET Software still has not given her the update. She is still waiting for that.
- IV. **RADAR SPEED SIGN UPDATE** – Chief, Spafford informed the committee that the radar speed sign seems to be working as well as the solar panel for that sign. There have been no issues.
- V. **REVIEW OF ORDINANCES** – Ordinance #1-2015 was reviewed. This ordinance pertains to amending Chapter 98, Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Municipal Code for the Village of Webster. The ordinance discussed requirements for dog licensing, vaccinations, issuance and multiple dog license requirements. Ordinance #2-2015 was reviewed. This ordinance pertains to amending Chapter 248, Sections 6, 7 and 8 of the Municipal Code for the Village of Webster. The ordinance pertains to snowmobile regulations in the Village of Webster. Ordinance #3-2015 was reviewed. This ordinance was recreated in Chapter 249 of the Municipal Code for the Village of Webster. The ordinance pertains to ATV regulations in the Village of Webster. There was one addition made to Chapter 249, Section 3 (Routes designated). Oak Street East was added. There was one addition to Chapter 249, Section 4 (Conditions). Item E “All ATV operators must have operating brake lights and turn signal lights. If these are not in operating order, use of hand signals are mandatory” was added. Motion to recommend the full board approve all ordinances was made by Chairman, Weis; seconded by Village President, Roberts after change to Ordinance #3-2015 was made. **Motion carried 3-0.**
- VI. **WORK IMPROVEMENT WEBSTER PD DISCUSSION** – There has been much improvement in the department the committee noted. Chief, Spafford discussed his budget and items that may need to be purchased.
- VII. **MOTION TO ADJOURN** – Motion to adjourn the Judicial Committee Meeting at 6:52 p.m. was made by Chairman, Weis; seconded by Village President, Roberts. **Motion carried 3-0.**
