- I. CALL TO ORDER** – Charlie Weis, Judicial Chairman; called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
 - II. ROLL CALL** – Chairman, Charlie Weis; Village President, Jeff Roberts; and Members, Sarah Casady, Tim Maloney, and Darrell Sears. Also Present: Police Chief, Mike Spafford; Police Officer, Bridget Getts; Mike Zelinski and Mike Trott. Absent: Municipal Clerk of Courts, Tessa Anderson.
 - III. MUNICIPAL COURT REVIEW** – Due to weather, Municipal Clerk of Courts will send the Municipal Court Review to committee members.
 - IV. INTRODUCE LEDC MEMBERS** – Chairman, Weis introduced Mike Zelinski as an LEDC Member.
 - V. REVIEW SCHOOL LIAISON PROJECT** – Police Chief, Spafford and Officer, Getts reported that there have been 88 calls for service for K-12; majority of this number represents calls to 5-12 building. The police department is working with Northwest Passage for implementing mood training and reported on home visits with parents of truancy student. The committee will recommend to the full board to continue the school liaison project until the end of the school year.
 - VI. POLICE CHIEF'S 2018 PROJECTS** – Chief, Spafford provided the committee with a list of 10 projects that he will be working on for 2018. This list can be obtained from the Village Clerk/Treasurer.
 - VII. APRIL 25, 2017 WORK IMPROVEMENT PLAN** – The committee reviewed and discussed the work improvement plan from April 25, 2017. The committee will review the full work improvement.
 - VIII. HUNTING WITHIN VILLAGE LIMITS** – Village resident, Mike Trott, expressed his concerns about ordinances involving hunting in the village limits. The committee discussed hunting within the village limits and will make a recommendation to the full village board that no hunting be allowed within the Village limits. Present ordinances will be updated.
 - IX. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT** – The conditional use permit was not provided by the resident making the request.
 - X. UPDATED ORDINANCES** – There was no action taken on the updated ordinances.
 - XI. MOTION TO ADJOURN** – Motion to adjourn the Judicial Committee Meeting at 7:30 p.m. was made by Member, Casady; seconded by Village President, Roberts. **Motion carried 3-0.**
