# JUDICIAL MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, September 15, 2020 @6:00 p.m.

Webster Community Center

7421 Main Street West, Webster, WI

- I. **CALL TO ORDER** –Judicial Chairman, Charlie Weis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
  - II. **PRESENT** – Chairman, Charlie Weis; Village President, Jeff Roberts; Member, Bill Summer; Trustee, Tim Maloney. Others Present: Municipal Court Clerk, Tessa Anderson; Police Chief, Stephenie Wedin and Oakland Town Chairman, Wayne Larrabee. Absent: Member, Darrell Sears.
  - III. **POSSIBLE LAW ENFORCEMENT IN OAKLAND TOWNSHIP** – Oakland Town Chairman, Wayne Larrabee explained that they are working on their ten-year plan. Oakland is experiencing population growth issues. Burnett County Sheriff's department only has one officer covering the township and this is not meeting their needs. Chairman, Larrabee is asking for some time from the Village for police coverage. The areas of need are police presence, prevention, enforcing noise ordinance (the Oakland Town Board is in the process of updating the noise ordinance), traffic and ATV/UTV use. Chairman, Larrabee is asking for a three to five-year agreement starting on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and include twelve hours per week of police coverage from the Village. The agreement would include a 6-month bailout where each party has to give a 6-month notice to withdraw from the agreement. He would like the Village to bill Oakland Township monthly. The village will put together a dollar per hour rate that will include wages, benefits, and vehicle costs. This rate will be given to Chairman, Larrabee by October 1, 2020.
  - IV. **MUNICIPAL COURT REVIEW** – The committee reviewed the Webster Municipal Court Statistics report. There is currently \$50,000 outstanding of which \$15,000 is juvenile tickets. Due to COVID-19, Court had been cancelled for May, June and July. Court is at the Community Center and held per the standards given by Health Department.
  - V. **SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER** –Officer, Barker is back at the school as the School Resource Officer and all is going well. The contract between the Village and the Webster School District has been signed. Chief, Wedin will check on billing the school monthly instead of a yearly.
  - VI. **2020 BUDGET REVIEW** – Clothing allowance is over budget due to the new tasers coming out of this account. The Full Time Police Officer is over budget because of the school being closed, due to COVID-19, for the months of April through June. All other budget items are in good shape.
  - VII. **MOTION TO ADJOURN** – Motion to adjourn the Judicial Committee Meeting at 7:10 p.m. was made by President, Roberts; seconded by Member, Summer. **Motion carried 4-0.**
