- I. **CALL TO ORDER** –Judicial Chairman, Jeff Roberts called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
  - II. **PRESENT** – Chairman, Jeff Roberts; Trustee, Tim Maloney; Trustee, Bill Summer. Others Present: Police Chief, Stephenie Wedin; Municipal Court Judge, Brian Sears and Municipal Court Clerk, Tessa Anderson. Trustee, Aaron Sears and Trustee, Charlie Weis.
  - III. **MUNICIPAL COURT REVIEW** – The Municipal Court Report was reviewed and discussed truancy issues.
  - IV. **UPDATE ON HIRING NEW POLICE OFFICER** – An interview to fill the open police officer position will be scheduled for June 30<sup>th</sup> or July 1<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 p.m.
  - v. **UPDATE ON EQUIPMENT, RADIOS AND SQUADS** - Chief, Wedin informed the committee that the police department is entitled to \$7000 reimbursement through ARPA funding for police use.
  - VI. **RENTER IN COMMUNITY CENTER OFFICE SPACE** – Discussed situations involving a current renter of office space in the basement of the Community Center. The rental agreement will be amended.
  - VII. **ABANDONED VEHICLES AND PROPERTY MAINTENANCE** – A letter will be sent to six property owners of old and dilapidated buildings asking them to either make the building habitable or raze the building. If no action is taken in ninety days, the Village will take action. President, Roberts will talk to the school about moving the school bus that is by the highway and Ken Erickson about moving his advertising truck.
  - VIII. **MOTION TO ADJOURN** – Motion to adjourn the Judicial Committee Meeting at 7:00 p.m. was made by Trustee, Maloney; seconded by Trustee, Summer. **Motion carried 3-0.**
