

## Webster Arts and Crafts Extravaganza

**Saturday, May 23, 2026, 9 am – 4 pm**

Dear Artist or Crafter,

The Webster Arts and Crafts Extravaganza hosted by the Webster Area Chamber of Commerce takes place on the Saturday before Memorial Day which is Saturday May 23, 2026. As in the past, the event is from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

This arts and craft fair will be held on the Webster High School soccer field, the same outside location as last year. There is no electricity and generators are not allowed.

Sites are \$70.00 each and will be approximately 12x12 ft.

Applications from returning artists and crafters should be postmarked by March 31st, 2026 to be guaranteed a site. We will try to give returning sellers the same space as last year unless you request a different area.

Decisions on new applications will be made as they come in. If an application is denied, you will be notified immediately. An acceptance letter and map will be sent in mid-May 2026 to all accepted vendors.



**To avoid issues during set up, as soon as your vehicle is unloaded it must be moved to allow others access to unload their vehicles.** No vehicles are allowed on the field with the possible exception of furniture sellers. (The condition of the field on that day will determine if a seller can drive onto the field, so ask when you arrive.)

Please only park in areas designated for sellers. **Anyone not obeying parking rules will not be invited back.** If you are handicapped, we will make exceptions, but we must know this ahead of time. **No other exceptions.**
